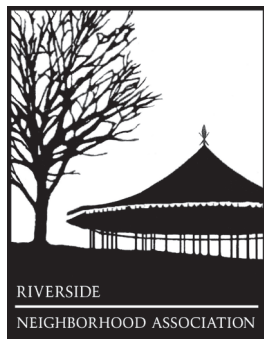

## Development – Ann Fiocco

**BGE – Phase II** – Nearing completion. Paving and sidewalk replacement is also nearing completion.

**Phase III** – Gas line replacement is well underway by Asplundh. Everyone is encouraged to schedule your line replacement as soon as you are contacted. The faster people schedule, the faster this work will be completed. No paving will begin in Phase III until all work is completed within the boundaries of this Phase.

### Curb Bump Outs

In conjunction with Phase II of the gas line replacement the curb extension project should begin on Randall. This will greatly enhance pedestrian safety along this corridor. Bump outs are planned for Randall/Webster, Riverside/Randall, Johnson/Randall, with slight revisions to the existing curbs and crosswalks at Randall/Johnson and Randall/Covington.



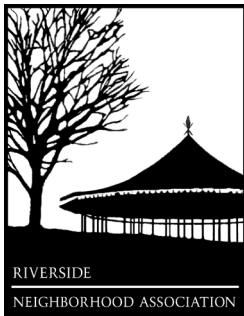
