Frequently Asked Questions - John G. Paré Jr.

Riverside Neighborhood Association fields a lot of questions related to our neighborhood. I have compiled a few of the most frequently asked questions with the answers.

Q. I am having a party and would like to rent the Gazebo in the park, how do I go about reserving it?


A. Although the Friends of Riverside Park (neighborhood volunteers) work to make the park a beautiful backdrop for any social event, reserving the Gazebo is handled by Baltimore City's Department of Recreation and Parks. For more information on permits, visit their website at http:// bcrp.baltimorecity.gov/rec-parks-permits.

Q. Can I have a gathering in the park without renting the gazebo?

A. Riverside Park is a public park, and you do not need a permit to use part of the park for a social gathering. If you do, there are three items to keep in mind-grilling is not allowed, alcohol is not allowed, and your area is not dedicated or reserved.

about what is happening in Riverside. Get information on events like the Riverside summer concert series and our community yard sales and updates on ongoing initiatives like our Citizen on Patrol (COP) walks and the BGE pipeline project.

We also have a Facebook group called RNA Connect. Follow the link from our main Facebook page to request to join your neighbors in discussing community issues and concerns. You can ask questions and get recommendations, or just post community information.

Q. If I see suspicious activity (but not necessarily criminal activity), should I still call 911?

A. Yes, report all suspicious activity and let the Baltimore Police do their job.

Q. I am planning to do some remodeling work on my home—what projects do I need permits for?

**A.** Visit baltimorehousing.org for permitting information. The section on "ePermits" will allow you to apply for a permit 24 hours a day, send and receive messages about your permit, pay for your permit, and receive your permit via email.




and productive. All neighbors are welcome to help themselves to any of the herbs and veggies that are growing there.
