

BGE - Phase II - Nearing completion. Paving and sidewalk replacement is also nearing completion.



Curb Bump Outs

Bump outs are planned for Randall/Webster, Riverside/Randall, Johnson/Randall, with slight revisions to the existing curbs and crosswalks at Randall/Johnson and Randall/Covington.




