# Test Your Knowledge of Voting Trivia - John G. Paré Jr.

With Election Day right around the corner—Tuesday, November 8, it's a great time to brush up on your voting trivia. Answer the below questions true or false and see how you fare.

#### True or False—

\*\*\*Votes cast by absentee and early voting ballots are counted only if there is a tie.

Answer: False. Votes cast during early voting and by absentee ballot count just like votes cast on Election Day.

# \*\*\*Maryland has 10 electoral votes to cast for the President of the United States.

Answer: True. Maryland has 10 electoral votes, which is 1.8 percent of the 538 total electoral votes and 3.7 percent of the 270 electoral votes needed to win the general election.

#### \*\*\*George Washington paid off voters with Election Day drinking

Answer: True. In 1758, George Washington ran as representative in Virginia for the House of Burgesses. He spent his entire campaign budget, 50 pounds, on 160 gallons of liquor served to 391 voters.

#### \*\*\*I cannot vote if I have been convicted of a felony.

Answer: False. Effective, July 1, 2007, if you have been convicted of a felony and have completed serving a court-ordered sentence of imprisonment, including any term of parole or probation, you are eligible to register to vote.

# \*\*\*In 1872, Susan B. Anthony was arrested for attempting to vote in the presidential election.

Answer: True. American women did not win the right to vote until 1920—less than 100 years ago.

# \*\*\*I have to already be registered to vote in order to vote during the early voting period.

Answer: False. Although registered voters have always been able to vote during early voting, now individuals who are eligible but not yet registered can register and vote during early voting. To register and vote during early voting, go to an early voting center in the county where you live and bring a document that proves where you live. Early voting for the 2016 general election is from Thursday, October 27, through Thursday, November 3, 2016 from 8 a.m. until 8 p.m.

#### \*\*\*I can find all the voter information I need online.

A: True. The Maryland Board of Elections at www. elections.state.md.us can answer all of your voter and Election Day questions.

It has been said that "bad officials are elected by good citizens who do not vote." Regardless of which candidate wins--this year's election will be historic. I personally believe that voting is one of the most important civic obligations citizens have. This is true not just for our national leaders, but for our state and local leaders. I encourage you to take advantage of this privilege, make your voice heard, and vote.

#### **Daffodil Planting**

Keep a eye out in the spring for several new sets of bulbs along Johnson and Randall Streets. 
#### **Gazebo Rennovation**




