

The Census: An American Tradition

In the next couple of months, you will start to see letters arrive in the mail inviting you and your household to participate in the 2020 Census. For those unaware, the census is a constitutionally mandated count of the country's population which occurs once every ten years. This year's census will mark the 24th time, since 1790, that the United States has conducted such an event. The information gathered from the census is vital for the following decade as it determines how hundreds of billions of federal funding gets distributed among states, communities, and various support programs. State legislatures or independent bipartisan commissions also use the data to redraw congressional districts, based on where populations have increased or decreased.

The whole country stands to benefit from completing the census, especially Baltimore. According to the Baltimore City website, the census can provide around \$900 million annually through Federal Assistance Programs. These programs include Federal Pell Grants, National School Lunch Program, Child Care, Unemployment Insurance, Crime Victim Assistance, and many others. The city hopes to capture a complete and accurate count for this year's census and aims for a self response rate of 73 percent.

Completing the census is easy and private. The 2020 Census website states that Title 13 of the U.S. Code prohibits the Census Bureau from releasing any identifiable information about you to anyone, including law enforcement agencies. Starting March 12, households in Baltimore will receive an invitation in the mail inviting them to participate online in the 2020 Census. If not completed, households will receive reminders every so often until late April when the US Census will start to follow up in person. If you wish to help more, the Baltimore City Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs will be hosting two more training sessions this month for Census Ambassador volunteers. The first session will be on February 20th at 6 p.m., at the Moravia Park Elementary School, and the second session will be on February 29th at 10:30 a.m., at the YMCA in Waverly.


March 7: Plant a Silly Succulent

Starting this spring, there will be a new BCRP Sports Turfgrass unit based out of the service building in Riverside Park. The focus of this group will be on ballfield improvements and managing the sports turfgrass for BCRP facilities citywide. Balt City Rec and Parks is currently working on renovations to the service building (new roof/water lines/utilities). The fully staffed unit will be between 2-7 people so the impact on the area should be minor. With the field improvements coming to Riverside Park in the next year, we are very excited to have this group located onsite. Once the unit is moved in, RNA is planning to have an introductory meet and greet with the residents and employees.















Riverside Renovations

The planning phase for the Riverside renovations is moving along according to schedule. Currently, the environmental assessment, storm water management, and construction plans are in the works. There are two projects that will be run concurrently: the field renovation and the red field house renovation. Both projects are expected to begin construction in Fall 2020. Construction on the field renovation is expected to last 9 months and will close the lower field for the duration of the project. Construction on the red field house is expected to last 6 months. The next phase will be soliciting construction bids which should take place this summer.
